## **Mythos Mosel**

## Mythos Mosel. Eine Riesling Reise.

The second event of Mythos Mosel. Eine Riesling Reise was held from May 29 - 31, 2015. After an impressive debut in 2014, a great second episode in 2015, the third time is anticipated impatiently in June 2016.

More than 2.000 visitors from all over the world came to experience and taste the myth of the Mosel region this May. Not only wines but also the unique environment and diversity of old wineries made this event a unique experience. One of the biggest highlights was the opening event in Schloss Lieser,

the former Schorlemer residence that was remodeled by a Dutch business man in the last few years

and is now to become a hotel, wellness, spa for international tourists and Mosel-lovers. The opening

event was an exclusive party with well-known, regional chefs who presented culinary regional

specialties as well as international Riesling-matching foods such as Sushi and Sashimi. The core Mythos

Mosel – two days of travelling inbetween an area of 20km along the Mosel - hosted famous vintners

such as Dr. Loosen, JJ Prüm or Fritz Haag. Also young, dynamic winemakers from the region made their

impressions and presented their steep slope wines from Kesten to Zeltingen.

In 2016 Mythos Mosel will take place for the third time. The route will now involve the area from Ürzig

to Pünderich, 25 hosts have already confirmed their participation and are ready to welcome

international visitors to taste their wines. As well as in lasts years' events a bus shuttle service will

enable all guests to commute between the villages. Again the route is chosen carefully thus visitors

may also travel by bike or even walk inbetween the villages. The opening event will be not less

sensational than last year: It will be held in the "Moselschlösschen", located in Traben-Trarbach. The

"Moselschlösschen" situated in the art nouveau city of Traben-Trarbach impresses with a stunning

court yard with a beautiful view to the Moselle. The property with its original features that have been

lovingly and with much care restored offers the ideal territory for an opening-party. Again regional

chefs will provide the menu at different cooking stations. Wines of all participants will be available in

big bottles, accompanying each meal perfectly. Following to the opening party, visitors can expect two

days filled with a great variety of Mosel's finest wines, winemakers, estates and the beautiful

landscape of the region.
